Travel & Parking

Thousands of people will be aiming for the start/finish line outside the community centre. We encourage allowing plenty of time ahead of the start. We also encourage sustainable travel, such as public transport or lift sharing and offer a park and ride facility from the Aberafan Shopping Centre Carpark, Llewellyn St Port Talbot, Port Talbot, Neath SA13 IPB and Port Talbot Parkway train station/ bus station.

Toilets & Showers

There will be several toilet facilities on the main stretch and Event Village. Please see map for location. The men's showers are located in the rugby club, the women's are located in Parc Siencyn Powell and there are mixed showers at the Squash club (next the football club).

Running Number & Timing Chip

Your race pack contains a running number with an embedded timing chip. Pin the running number to the FRONT of your vest or t-shirt before the race to ensure your finish time is recorded. The timing chip will enable us to provide you with a 'chip time' (beginning when your running number crosses the start/finish

Baggage

A baggage facility will be available before the race, open from 08:00am. It will be in Cwmavon Library near the Event Village. Runners can deposit one bag, there is a baggage label on the numbers which can be ripped off. Valuables are left at your own risk.

Cut Off Time & Road Re-Opening

The event carries a 2.5 hour cut off time, to ensure roads can safely re-open within a reasonable time frame to minimise impact on the village. Those wishing to continue must do so on the pavement (as roads re-open) and do so at their own risk – no longer as a part of the event.

Your Safety

If at any time during the race you feel unable to continue, please stop, rest and locate the nearest marshal.

Head to the Event Village after the race to soak up the community atmosphere, enjoy some entertainment and grab some tasty street food.


